With this goal in mind committees have been organized, headed by group leaders, which are designed to help us operate in a more professional way. You are being asked to look over the list of committees and associated tasks below, and decide which one you will join. Depending on the needs in each area, you may be called upon to help out only 2 or 3 times a year. Members who wish to make a major contribution, which does not fall into the categories listed below, are asked to contact the President or Vice President.

Check and purchase kitchen supplies with direction from Lucie or Debara. Clean and tidy kitchen and related areas.

Be involved in small projects depending on your abilities and talents.

At openings work with a convener to set up social area, assist with food presentation, assure coffee is available, and perform closing task such as clean-up and putting away some furniture.
